### **Maths**

Can you find the difference between two amounts of money? This can be helpful when working out change, or how much more money you need to buy something. If you are finding the difference between two similar numbers you would count on from the smaller number eg  $\pounds 16 - \pounds 13 =$  (count on from 13 to 16). If the numbers wouldn't be very close on a number line, then you could count back eg  $\pounds 16 - \pounds 4 =$  (count back 4 from 16). Try the 'mild' and 'hot' questions. Can you complete the extra challenge?

### **English**

This sheet has different activities for practising correct use of spelling, punctuation and grammar. Just write your answers on paper, and then check the answer sheet on Friday.

I have also included a list of spellings that you could practise this week. They are all common exception words. Can you write each word in a sentence correctly? You can also use this opportunity to practise your neat, cursive handwriting.
