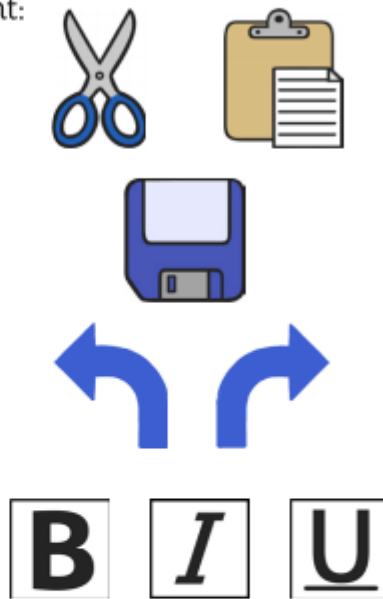
## Foundations Subject – Computing

- <ctrl> + A select all
- <ctrl> + S save
- <ctrl> + Z undo
- <ctrl> + Y redo
- <ctrl> + B bold
- <ctrl> + I italics
- <ctrl> + U underline
