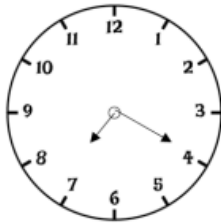
Wednesday 1st July - Answers

Maths – Time

The board shows the times of trains arriving and leaving the train station.

	Arrives	Leaves
London	5:50 a.m.	6:00 a.m.
Edinburgh	8:00 a.m.	8:20 a.m.
Manchester	2:33 p.m.	2:45 p.m.
Leeds	7:31 p.m.	7:35 p.m.

Ron's watch shows the time he arrives at the station.



Which train could he be catching?
Explain how you know.

Answer – Ron's watch shows 20 past 7 – but we don't know if this is morning or afternoon as it is an analogue clock. Ron is most likely to be catching the train to Leeds. He could also be catching the train to Edinburgh, but he is quite early for that one!
