


Today we will be using scales to measure mass in kilograms - kg



REMEMBER

There are 1000 grams in 1 kilogram.

We can write **g** for gram. We can write **kg** for kilogram. **1000g = 1 kg**

We measure heavier objects using kilograms.

What objects are heavier than a kilogram? What objects are lighter than a kilogram? 1 Ka
