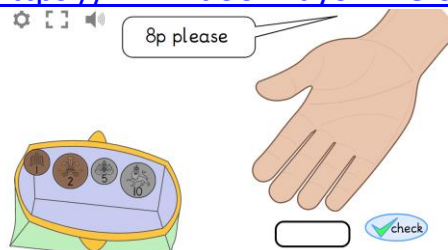


## Maths

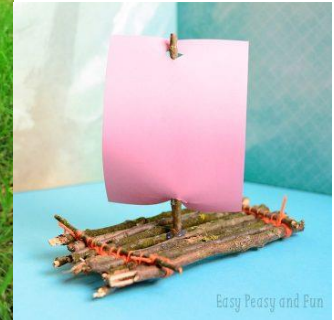
Next, read the clues below and write the correct 'oa' word for each one.
