
Maths

Today you will finish the work on time with the reasoning and mastery questions linked to Wednesday and the 24 hour clock. I have also uploaded some time problems for you to have a go at!


Reasoning

Three children are meeting in the park.


Rosie says,



Teddy says,




Eva says,
