We're going to move on and look at am and pm.

When a time is followed by 'am', it means that the time has happened before midday.

These are all times in the morning.

When a time is followed by 'pm', it means that the time has happened after midday.

These are all times in the afternoon and night time.

We say that midday is 12pm and midnight is 12am.

Look at these events and sort them into whether they happen in the morning or afternoon.

Sort the events into the time of day that they might happen.
