Today's rhyme: Octopus Counting to 8


Join in singing while practising counting to 8 – remembering to hold your fingers up to match the number.

Art:

Make your own octopus

- Paint a paper plate for the octopus body and leave to dry.
- Cut 8 equal lengths of matching coloured card to make wavy tentacles.
- Decorate the middle of the plate to add 'eyes'.
- Attach the tentacles to the reverse of the plate from half-way across and downwards.
