Art:**A Beautiful Butterfly**

You will need:

- Different bright coloured paint & brushes
- A large piece of paper
- Scissors

Fold the paper in half and with adult support, draw 1 side of the butterfly against the fold – pencil outline only.

Next, the same half of the butterfly can be painted in a bold design using the bright coloured paint and with reminders of colours or patterns seen in today's video with Aunty Mabel.



Carefully fold the unused side of paper on top of the painted side to copy the same patterned wings across. Press down and smooth with both hands to imprint. Unfold and leave to dry flat.



Lastly, cut your own butterfly out. Practise slow, careful cutting.
