Foundation Subject – Science

Create a glossary for the scientific words we learnt in last week's lesson. Remember that a glossary gives the definitions of words. The poster or leaflet you made should help, as should the PowerPoint you looked at.

Can you write the meaning for the following words?

- Germination: Germination is when the plant begins to grow from a seed
- Pollination: Pollination is the transfer of pollen from the anther of one plant to the stigma of another
- Fertilisation: Fertilisation is when the pollen travels down to the ovary and joins with an ovule to form a seed
- Seed: A seed is a small part produced by a plant from which a new plant can grow
- Seed Dispersal: Seed dispersal is when the seeds are moved away from the main plant so new plants can grow
- Stigma: A stigma is the upper part of a flower which receives the pollen grains

Also, where would you usually find a glossary? You'd usually find a glossary at the back of a non-fiction book. It explains what the technical vocabulary in the text means.
