Just a reminder that we are a Durham County Council school and have a strict no smoking policy, which includes on the concourse near the Academy on Passfield Way. Please can you stand back from the top of the steps, keeping the 2 metre distance rule and not crowd the exit so that children can see who is here to collect them.

CLASS DOJO: Thank you to all parents who have signed up to Class Dojo. I hope you are enjoying seeing your child's reward points and sharing in their successes. We are now assigning homework on Class Dojo, and there is more information about this on our Facebook page and school website.

REPORTING ABSENCE: Please note you are not able to report your child's absence via Class Dojo, calls must be made to the office before 9am as always. Thank you for your support.

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION: I am very pleased to see that the new drop off and collection system is working well and after chatting with parents and carers we are getting some very positive feedback. I will be looking at the timings of class release and may make some slight changes after half term.

WATER BOTTLES: Children are using their water bottles well and taking them into the hall to drink with their lunch- this avoids the use of cups and jugs and reduces the covid risk. Please make sure your child's bottle is unbreakable as some have glass in and we have had some breakages. I also ask that this bottle is used for **water only**. Parents may order milk via <u>www.coolmilk.com</u> if they wish their child to have milk at school. Children are not allowed to drink from their bottles while walking around the school as they may trip. Children are 'grazing' on their water bottles throughout the day as they have them on their desks. We encourage them to drink water to remain hydrated however, we are concerned about damage to their teeth if they bring flavoured water or juice into school. Some parents are telling us that their child does not like water but as a school, water has always been on offer and we have not offered juice. This is part of our healthy schools standard. Thank you for working with us on this matter.

PACKED LUNCH: We ask that you support us to create a culture of healthy eating and supply your child with appropriate midday food which provides energy to get through the afternoon session of learning. We expect your child's lunch to be of good nutritional value so we can encourage healthy eating habits from an early age. Children are not permitted to bring in hot foods in flasks as this is not safe in our environment. Please no sweets, chocolate bars, soups, thermos flasks. There is no need to send in a drink as your child will have their water bottle with them. One small cake or biscuit is allowed. We ask that crisps are only given twice a week.

Uneaten food will be sent home so you can monitor what your child has eaten. All wrappings will be sent home too. Please do not send excessive amounts of food into school as your child has a limited time to complete lunch as we must keep the class bubble together.

GRAPES: please make sure grapes are cut in half as they are a choking hazard. This applies to our older pupils too. NUTS: We are a nut free school and ask that you do not send any nut based products into school with your child as this causes severe allergic response in some of our pupils.

SCHOOL MEALS: Just a reminder you need to contact the office to give <u>**2 WEEKS NOTICE</u>** if you wish to change your child's meal arrangements from school meals to packed lunch or vice versa.</u>

PHONICS SCREENING CHECK Year 1 and 2: Cancellation of the phonics screening check in June 2020 means all current Year 2 pupils will sit the test in December 2020.

Year 2 pupils who meet the expected standard in phonics in the Autumn check will not be required to complete any further statutory assessments in Phonics. Year 2 pupils who do not meet the expected standard in the Autumn check will be expected to take the statutory check in June 2021, alongside Year 1 pupils. All children are receiving daily phonics lessons and intervention where needed. Please contact your child's class teacher via Class Dojo if you require any further information.

SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS: Tempest Photography will be in school on Monday 28th September to take single photographs. There will not be any family photos this year. This is a decision made by the company not the school.
