BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS: Breakfast Club is open to Reception children upto Year 6, this will not need to be booked in advance but will need to be paid for in advance please though Parentpay. The cost per day is £2 for the first child and £1 for any siblings. After School Club will be open to Reception children upto Year 6 children and is open on a Monday through to Thursday NOT FRIDAY'S. This MUST be booked and paid for 1 week in advance via Parentpay please, no payment will result in your child not being able to attend. We also require 24hrs notice to cancel your child's place in After School Club otherwise you will be charged. Please contact the school office to reserve a place for your child. The cost per day is £4 for the first child and £3.50 for any siblings.

**POLITE REMINDER:** We would like to remind you that as a DCC School there is a **NO SMOKING** policy in place for in or around the school site, this includes E-cigarettes. Thank you for your cooperation.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE: Please remember to complete a leave of absence form for any time taken out of school time. Thank you.

**APPOINTMENTS:** Please contact the office to inform us of any appointments your child has to attend during school time. Office staff do not see messages sent to teachers via dojo.

**WEARABLE TECHNOLOGY:** Please could we remind parents that pupils are NOT allowed to wear Apple watches or Smart watches in school as they can be connected to the Internet and are also expensive items. This applies to jewellery in general, a small stud earring can be worn in the ear but necklaces, bracelets and other hooped or dangle earrings are prohibited in school. **Earrings should be removed for P.E or plasters provided from home to cover them.
