Dear Parents and Carers

This has been a difficult week for getting your children to and from school with the wind, rain and snow and we recognise the parking issues around the school. However, we have received complaints from residents on Waveney Road this week about the dangerous driving and the poor parking from people attending the school site. We believe walking to school is the best way forward if you live locally but respect that for some of you this is not an option, particularly in the icy weather.

Our greatest concern is the parking across dropped kerbs, on corners, on grass verges, in front of garages, blocking residents driveways and parking on yellow lines. We are also concerned about our children running out in to the line of traffic and putting themselves at risk- we have had a number of near misses lately. Please do not use our school drive entrance as a turning point as this must not be blocked as it is an emergency exit. Take particular care when coming into Waveney Road from Passfield Way as this is on a slope and dangerous when icy. Keep your speed low as this will allow everyone else to see, think and act safely. We are expecting visits from the police to monitor parking- their advice is for concerned residents to report directly to them. I also politely request that you turn down loud music as some of our neighbours work night shift and are sleeping. Please work with us to keep our whole community safe and well. Thank you.

CLASSES 9 & 10: Children can wear their xmas jumpers on Friday 17th December as they will be wearing party clothes on the Thursday.

WEARABLE TECHNOLOGY: Please could we remind parents that pupils are not allowed to wear Apple watches or Smart watches in school as they can be connected to the Internet and are also expensive items.

JEWELLERY: Small stud earrings can be worn but necklaces, bracelets and other hooped or dangle earrings are not allowed for safety reasons. Earrings must be removed for P.E or plasters provided from home to cover them.

BREAKFAST CLUB: Breakfast Club is open to Reception children up to Year 6, this does not need to be booked but will need to be paid for in advance please through Parentpay. The cost per day is £2 for the first child and £1 for any siblings.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB: 'Night Owls' Club must be booked and paid for 1 week in advance via Parentpay and we are unable to accept last minute bookings. Requests for emergency care for children must be discussed and approved by Mrs Boyd or the senior lead in school. The club is open to Reception children up to Year 6 from Monday to Thursday. Due to low numbers there is no club on Friday.

Collection is via the day gate which needs to be pushed as it does not open automatically and from the small hall doors next to reception. We do not release children to walk down the drive for safeguarding reasons. Siblings must be minimum 14 yrs of age to collect other siblings and a form will need to be completed to authorise this. **Children must be collected no later than 5 pm.**

CONTACT DETAILS: Please can you ensure we have up to date contact numbers in case of illness or accidents in school.

PACKED LUNCHES: We operate as a healthy school. Please see the food policy on our website for more information. Children with sweets and chocolates will not be able to eat them at lunchtime so please do not put them in their lunch boxes. A small cake or biscuit bar is acceptable.

PARENTPAY: Please pay by card rather than bank transfer as these take longer to process. Please pay for dinners either weekly or monthly in advance.

ADDITIONAL DAYS HOLIDAY: as advised by DCC we have identified an additional days holiday as Friday 18th February 2022. Children will return to school Tuesday 1st March 2022.
